



Middle Level School Activities -- PROTECT Your ELIGIBILITY

Please Post in a Conspicuous Place !!!

To Participate in Athletics you must:

1. Be less than 16 years old prior to June 1 of the previous school year for junior high.
2. Be less than 15 years old prior to June 1 of the previous school year for 7th and 8th grade athletics.
3. Have been in school last semester.
4. Be enrolled and in regular attendance within the first 15 school days of the current semester or 10 schools days of the current trimester in order to participate in the current semester/trimester.
5. Regularly attend classes and do passing work in a minimum of four full-time subjects.
6. Have passed a physical examination from a medical authority licensed to perform a physical examination during the 12-month period prior to first participation in high school. A medical authority must approve in writing continued participation annually. The medical authorities licensed and approved by law to give physicals include M.D.; Doctor of Osteopathy, D.O.; Certified Registered Nurse (C.R.N.) and Physician's Assistant (P.A.); Naturopaths (N.D.).
7. Have athletic injury insurance approved by your school (if required).

To Participate in Athletics You Cannot:

8. Compete in a sport for more than 2 years in the 7th and 8th grade, whether it is partial or total season participation. Beginning in the 9th grade, a student has 4 consecutive years of eligibility.
9. Participate concurrently in more than one interscholastic sport per season.
10. Accept, from any source whatever, awards of intrinsic value except letters award by your school or medals or trophies given in middle level school contests (applies to players on school teams).
11. Accept any cash award or prizes totaling, more than \$100.00 in value for athletic activity in one calendar year, play on any professional team in any sport, sign a professional athletic contract or enter a competition under an assumed name.

To Participate in Athletics You Can:

12. Participate in any sport summer camp or clinic. (Check with your AD for fall sport restrictions.)

Your Eligibility is Subject to Special Rules:

13. If you want to participate in non-school athletic activities.
14. If your parents do not live in this school district.
15. If you transfer from one school to another within the last school year.

NOTE: There are a few additions and exceptions to the above rules. There may also be additional school and league requirements. Consult your principal or athletic administrator and/or the school, league and WIAA Handbook for precise wording of regulations.
