

3rd Grade Orchestra Sign up 2008-2009

Learning a new instrument (or continuing with a current instrument) is one of the most rewarding experiences a child can have! Students can pick from violin or viola. Students who plan to participate in orchestra will need an instrument. You can get information on renting or buying an instrument from your local music stores (Music Unlimited and Ted Brown Music). Be careful of websites like ebay – sometimes you get a great deal, and other times you end up with an instrument shaped object. If you cannot afford to rent or buy an instrument, Lewis and Clark has some instruments available for students to borrow for the school year. These instruments are checked out on a first come, first served basis. Students will need to buy a book for class: Essential Elements 2000 for strings – they will be instrument specific (violin, viola, cello, bass). They are available at Music Unlimited and Ted Brown Music. 3rd grade orchestra will rehearse as follows:

Tuesday: 3:20-3:40 (will need to arrange for prompt transportation)

Thursday: Lunch Recess

Students will receive a grade for their participation in orchestra. This grade is based on regular attendance, effort, and performance attendance.
