## Learning Resources





Our schools may be closed but we know our students are still eager to learn. Here's what we can tell you about our efforts to help keep their minds sharp while they are away from the classroom:

- We have begun building a variety of recommended activities, links to free online resources and other resources students and their families may use while schools are closed. These materials are supplemental—students are not required to complete assignments. We are also working with teachers to develop ways for them to stay in regular contact with their students and help them stay engaged in learning. <u>View Learning Resources.</u>
- Elementary school staff are working to set aside Chromebooks for students in Grades 2-5 and other materials for all students to use while schools are closed. Parents of those students will be able to start picking up those items for their children beginning Thursday. District administrators are developing a pickup schedule that will follow social distancing guidelines.
- We understand that some of our families do not currently have Internet access in their homes, making it difficult for their children to stay connected to their teachers. Charter Communications will offer free Spectrum broadband and Wi-Fi Internet access for 60 days to households with K-12 and/or college students who do not already have a Spectrum broadband subscription and at any service level up to 100 Mbps. Families may enroll by calling 1-844-488-8395. Installation fees will be waived for new student households.
- District administrators are working to address questions regarding Advanced Placement, Running Start and College In The High School courses and will update families as soon as possible.
